RECREATIONAL: \$65 before January 15 / **\$95** after January 15
(subtract \$20 for players who played in Fall 2011 ~ subtract \$5 for each subsequent child)

Full fee due with this form by January 15. Includes 1 practice per week & 6-8 games (depending on rain outs), uniform once a year (same uniform is used from fall to spring), trophy or medal, snack & drink after home games. All games are played in Fairview if there are enough teams (usually up through U10). If there are less than 4 teams, games will be played in Fairview & surrounding areas (usually U12 & above).

HEAT ACADEMY: \$120 for players born 8/1/04-7/31/06 **\$175** for players born on or before 7/31/04

The Heat Academy is a developmental program that offers a higher level of instruction and competition to players that would like to have success beyond the recreational level. The program teaches the necessary skills required to play competitive or school soccer. The academy is open to all U6-U18 players. The fee can be paid in 2 payments for early registrants-half due with this form, the other half due by January 15. Fee includes 1-2 practices per week with a licensed coach/trainer, 8 games, uniform once a year (same uniform is used from fall to spring), participation award, snack & drink after home games. Games will be played in Fairview and surrounding areas.

Heat Academy tryouts for U9 & above players who did not play in the fall will be held at the beginning of January (details at fairviewsoccer.com). Depending on skill level and numbers, players will be placed on an academy team or a rec team. Players placed on a rec team will attend academy training in addition to their rec team practices – guest player opportunities will also be available. - ~ Please remember we do not keep score below the U-10 level...this is a time for the kids to just have fun learning the game and how to work as a team.

I certify that the information provided is correct and will provide proof of age if asked to do so by FSA. Additionally, as a parent or legal guardian of the player named on this form, I hereby give my consent for emergency medical and/or dental care in the event of an injury associated with an FSA sponsored soccer game or practice. I will accept responsibility for all payment of these services. This care may be given under whatever conditions necessary in an attempt to preserve life, limb or well-being of my dependent.

I consent and agree that my child's name, picture, voice, verbal statements, portraits (video or still) may be used by FSA for club publications, on the club website, in club related video productions, or for news and other publications.

I understand that any fan, myself included, may be required to leave the soccer fields if in the opinion of the referee (or other official) that they have become a nuisance, out of control or aggressive to the point where they no longer make soccer fun for the kids or less enjoyable for the other fans.

FSA PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

- **I shall not criticize referees.**

Many of our referees are young and learning how to officiate much as your children are learning to play. Please be patient and treat them as if they were your own child.

- **I shall not "Grand Stand" or "sideline" Coach.**

It's very difficult to teach children the game, foster a competitive spirit "and" deal with unruly or demanding parents. Please try to be a cooperative, helpful parent that supports the coach and the team. Also, please refrain from being a "sideline coach." Do not sit behind goals or pace along the sideline shouting instructions.

- **I will set a good example of sportsmanship for the children.**

Yelling at referees, players on the field or coaches, shows great disrespect for soccer and sets a poor standard of sportsmanship. It is the team captain or coach's job alone to discuss any problems with the referees.

- **I will encourage my kids AND the rest of the kids on the team.**

Let's pump all these kids up so they'll have the time of their lives out there. Keep the comments positive and the results will be too!

- **I will address any team or player problems quietly and only with our team coach.**

Arguing or questioning the coach in public is detrimental to getting a successful resolution and sets a bad example for the players.

- **I will make an effort to attend and be on time to all team events.**

A commitment to the team is important, plus on game days, plenty of time should be allowed for proper warm ups to help avoid dangerous injuries. If you can't make it, please try to arrange for alternate transportation.

- **I will try to emphasize to my child that winning a game is the result of "team work."**

- **I will strive to make every soccer activity serve as a training ground for life and a basis for good mental and physical health.**

- **I will emphasize that good athletes strive to be good students.**

- **I will always refrain from using abusive or profane language. ABUSIVE OR PROFANE LANGUAGE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED ON THE SOCCER GROUNDS OR TOWARD ANY PERSON IN ATTENDANCE.**

- **USE OF TOBACCO AND TOBACCO PRODUCTS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON OR AROUND THE PLAYING FIELDS (anywhere on the grass). USE OF THESE PRODUCTS ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN DESIGNATED AREAS AWAY FROM THE PLAYERS (in the parking lot)**

- **I am aware that my coach is also my leader.**

Per the league rules, it is your coach's responsibility (and the referees) to monitor both the players and parents conduct.
